The invitation is open to family and friends.

- Work must be clearly labelled on back or base with name & contact details.
- We can display approximately 100 paintings/exhibits on the Picture Gallery. If we are over-subscribed, all entries will be judged but due to limited space, it may not be possible to display every entry in the Exhibition.
