Winemaker - Matthieu Elzinga

Tasting notes:

Medium crimson red this wine exhibits nuances of strawberry and red berry fruits with a hint of vanilla. The palate is smooth and rich with a velvety texture that is the hallmark of Pinot Noir

Food and wine:

Perfect with red meats and an ideal accompaniment to cheese

Composition:

A blend of Pinot Noir, Dunkelfelder, Regent and Rondo

Vineyard:

Pruning from 2013's excess took place between January and March of 2014. The warm spring lead to early onset of flowering in June and fruitset in early July.

The balmy temperatures and sunshine created excessive growth, necessitating canopy management. The removal of some of the fruit ensured the premium quality of the crop was maintained.

Winemaking:

The composite varietals were picked and harvested separately. Tannin management included délestage to preserve the fruit characteristics of the PN. 30% of the wine was introduced to oak with the balance aged in stainless steel to maintain freshness.
