Tasting notes:

Light pretty pink colour with wild strawberries, freshly cut pears and cracked pepper and thyme leaping from the glass. A dry, serious rose with great length and a fine line of acidity that carries these unique flavours with some persistency.

Excellent aperitif

Perfect accompaniment to salads, fish and BBQ's

Composition:

Dornfelder, Rondo and Pinot Noir. These grapes have been hand-picked.

Vineyard:

The vintage started with some frost damage but the spring time and summer were warm, enabling the fruit to ripen and build up interesting flavours.
