## Tasting notes:

### **Waitrose Trophy for Best English Still Rosé**

A full flavoured rosé, rich in colour, which benefits from the English cool climate.

A vibrant nose of summer fruits leads to a palate bursting with punnets of strawberries and raspberries, a hint of toffee apple and a persistent cassis finish.

## Excellent aperitif

- White meat
- Salads

## Composition:

Blend of Dornfelder and Pinot Noir from Denbies Vineyard.

## Winemaking:

The individual red grape varieties were gently pressed to achieve an elegant pink hue. Cool fermented at 15oC, the ferment was stopped before completion by refrigeration, in order to capture some of the natural sweetness in the grapes.
