

Pinot Noir 2016

Winemakers: John Worontschak and Matthieu Elzinga

Tasting notes: Rich ruby red in colour, the nose is spicy with peppery notes. The palate is vibrabt and floral with hints of cranberry and a creamy, velvety structure leading to a savoury finish.

Food matches:

- Light game dishes
- Charcuterie
- Hard full fat cheeses

Composition: As part of Denbies' Vineyard Select range, this wine is made only in the best of seasons from 100% hand-picked Pinot Noir.

Vineyard: The 2014 growing season was fantastic. Perfect flowering conditions followed by August rains and a warm September led to the early ripening of a healthy crop in the coolness of October.

Winemaking: Hand-picked fruit and whole berry pressed. Aged for 18 months in French oak barriques.
